

**QUANTITATIVE PSYCHOLOGY.** The Department of Psychology at The OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY seeks two outstanding candidates in quantitative psychology. Pending availability of funds, these positions are expected to be at the (1) Assistant or Associate and (2) Full levels, respectively. Candidates for both positions should have a background in psychometrics and a record of collaboration in other areas of psychology (e.g., cognitive, judgment and decision making, clinical, social). All applicants are expected to have strong and fundable research programs and to contribute to both graduate and undergraduate supervision and instruction.
