

The Department of Psychology at the UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH FLORIDA invites applications for a 9- month appointment of a tenure track scholar at the Assistant or Associate Professor level in TEAM OR GROUP PERFORMANCE AND TRAINING, with service to begin as early as August 7, 2012. Suitable backgrounds include all areas of psychology related to team performance enhancement. Although the appointment will be 100 percent in Psychology, the successful applicant will be expected to affiliate with the USF Center for Advanced Medical Learning and Simulation (CAMLS) to help develop, administer and evaluate team and individual medical training and measurement using simulations. CAMLS will provide support in the form of access to space, equipment and participants needed for medical training research. The successful applicant will be expected to establish an independent program of research that can garner extramural support, to supervise and mentor graduate students, to teach graduate and undergraduate classes, and to participate in departmental governance. Applicants must have the Ph.D. degree by the time of the appointment (August 7, 2012). The salary is negotiable. A review of applications will begin on November 1, 2011. Applications received after November 1, 2011 may be reviewed and advanced, in cases of compelling merit, up to the conclusion of the search process.
